Ida truly loved the game of golf and worked hard throughout her life to promote and improve women's golf, not only at Tuscarora, but in New York State. She was known in the sports community for her support of athletics in general, but known for being a driving force in Women's golf and Women's Jr. golf.

Ida was one of the founders of the Syracuse Women's District Golf Association. The SWDGA is the oldest women's golf association in the USA. She held the office of President in the TWGA, not once but several times.

Ida was a mentor for many, always encouraging you to improve your game. She was highly respected for her honesty, sense of fair play, her generosity and thoughtfulness of others.

For those that knew her well, her unique personality contained a wonderful sense of humor, a very competitive spirit, with a love for life and adventure.
